The people asked: "O Abu al-Hasan, how is the Messenger of Allah this morning?" He said: "He is feeling better this morning, by the grace of Allah."

They asked 'Ali (may Allah be pleased with him): "How is the Prophet (may Allah's peace and blessings be upon him) this morning?" 'Ali said: "He is feeling better this morning, by the grace of Allah."

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
